f you have ever had the misfortune of falling flat when standing erect, you will know that dreadful sensation of the ground rushing up to meet you. That is how India's economy feels. Twelve months ago all was hope and exuberance. Now we cringe at the hellish cacophony rising from a nation that seems fixated on devouring itself and its promise.

Nothing else matters – the financial reforms that must belong in the second decade of the 21st Century, the dire need for consensus and conciliation, the ability to be more than the craven politicians we do not deserve, the certitude that prosperity and well-being sweep many of our problems before them.
